V. **President's Report**

Old Business:

• Membership: We have 91 paying members so far. The winner of the \$25 Tweets Gift Card is Kara Lundin. We earned a NYS PTA Early Bird Membership Award for paying over 60% of

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our membership goal by 9/30. A Teacher/Staff membership drive is planned in the coming weeks.

- Fall sportswear closed 9/22. We took in \$210 profit. Thank you to everyone who purchased. We are looking to change vendors or designs to bring in a fresh look to our sportswear to increase sales.
- Picture Day was 10/4. Thank you to our volunteers.
- Finks Fall Festival was 10/7 and was well attended. We made a profit of \$1,614. Thank you to Rebecca Schwartz and Robyn Heavey for your assistance.
- Fall Book Fair was 10/11-10/14. 125 students signed up for eWallet and eWallet purchases were \$3,020.72. Our scholastic representative was very happy. The Monster Mash evening book fair was well attended. Total fair sales were \$9,475.76. With cash commission taken off our invoice, our profit is \$2,294.94. Thanks to Rebecca Carey, Christine Mangelli and Deborah Aiello for chairing this event.
- The Monster Mash on 10/14 was a huge success. Thank you to co-chairs Rachel McAdam and Amy McClelland, student and parent volunteers, and the PTA board for their hard work.
- Wildcat Wagon is selling well every other Thursday. Thank you to our volunteers and chair Robyn Heavey. Check our website for last minute volunteer cancellations/openings.
- Mosaic: The project finished ahead of schedule as students worked fast. Additional pieces were added in the art and music hallways so everyone was able to participate. Thank you to our volunteers. A small group of alumni and community members were notified by Mr. Parrinello and were able to participate. We purchased two gifts for artist Josh Winer: an engraved compass and poster collage signed by the students. An additional poster was given to the school. Thank you to Meghan Tepfenhardt for coordinating the gifts.
- Homecoming: The PTA gifted the school a banner with the slogan "Make It A Great Day". Students signed up to march with Mr. Parrinello via a google form. *This was the district's first Homecoming Parade since 2011 and all schools were represented.*
- A big thanks to Andrews Family Farm for donating festive fall flare for the Wading River School entrance! Thank you to Jen Oliveri for contacting them and delivering the items.

New Business:

• Candy Buy Back is 11/1-11/3. Send in unwanted candy for collection by Facing The Future Orthodontics to be sent to our troops overseas and local food banks. We will earn \$1 per lb. up to \$250. We will be weighing the candy daily – the grade that sends in the most wins! Thank you to Christine Mangelli for chairing this program. Redesigning the "Monsters" for candy collecting was discussed to make inputting candy easier.

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- Fall Blood Drive is Tuesday 11/8/22 from 2:30pm 7:00pm in the WRS Gymnasium. This date is also the Superintendent's conference day.
- Picture Retake Day is Tuesday 11/15/22: About half of staff took photos on picture day. We will need remaining staff to take pictures on retake day so we have them for the yearbook. Picture packages have been distributed to teachers. We discussed class photo mistakes. Discussions about reviewing other companies and contracts are in the works for next year.
- Family Game Night is Friday 11/18/22 from 6:00pm 8:00 pm. We discussed limiting tickets or limiting it to only WRS students and their parents versus having the entire family attend. The decision was made to allow the entire family to attend. The application has been submitted and the flier will go out shortly. Discussions were made regarding limiting the amount of attendees to between 240/260 guests max. The event will be hosted from 6:00pm-7:30pm with the Bingo game beginning at 6:15pm. We are still waiting for a teacher or staff to call the Bingo numbers. The location of the event will be held in the gym only with the only game offered to be bingo.
- Square 1 Art: students completed their sheets at home as Mosaic was done during art. Emma Tees sent back the art sheets on 10/19. Square 1 Art will mail the catalogs soon to the school, to go home with students. Only online orders will be taken, deadline is 11/23.
- Yearbook: Class Page Signup was posted to our website, Facebook and Remind. We need more volunteers. Annie Schlick stepped down from chairing but Kristy Molinelli will be chairing with Christine Rodgers and Lisa Eppelsheimer.
